ANNEX A: Queries and Clarifications

QUERIES / CLARIFICATIONS	ANSWERS
Do we need to indicate the CITEM solicitation number in our documents?	Yes.
In regards with the submission of bid documents, do we need to submit the original copy of the technical and financial component documents?	Yes. All documents should be an original copy.
Do we need to attach documents to support the Statement of Ongoing Government and Private Contracts?	Bidders should submit just the statement only. However, for the Statement of Single Largest and Completed Contract (SLCC), bidder should attach supporting documents such as the official receipts, sales invoice, and contracts.
For the Two-Way AI Noise Cancelling Audio Technology, is it okay for us to offer noise reduction instead of noise cancellation?	No. We prefer noise cancellation, which is better than noise reduction.
For the Fingerprint sensor, can we offer fingerprint sensor that is not integrated in the power button?	No, we prefer the integrated fingerprint sensor with the power button for easy access.
For the USB mouse, is it okay to include a mouse with a different brand from the laptop?	Yes.
Is the warranty for the USB mouse not included in the three (3) years warranty?	No. Warranty can be for one (1) year only.
Can we offer i7-1250U as processor instead of the i7-1255U?	No. Our minimum requirement is i7-1255U.
