TERMS OF REFERENCE

RATIONALE

In reaching out to buyers all over the world we use English, as it is the most spoken language in the world. But there are important market segments that can only understand and convey messages in their native tongue. This is where consecutive interpretation comes in.

Hiring the services of a professional interpretation provider is needed in ensuring the success of the buyer campaign strategies designed for Digital IFEX Philippines , specifically the Roadshows and the B2B activities. Communicating with non-English speaking buyers with the aid of consecutive interpretation will greatly help exhibitors connect with these buyers, conduct their business and eventually generate sales.

OBJECTIVE

To ensure a seamless flow of communication between the non-English speaking buyers and the exhibitors during the IFEX Roadshow and B2B activities.

SCOPE OF WORK

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QUALITATIVE EVALUATION
